

**AGENDA ITEM #4: COLISEUM CENTRAL SPECIAL EVENTS MANAGEMENT PLAN STUDY:
FINAL APPROVAL**

SUBJECT:

This study is the result of a request by the City of Hampton that HRTPO staff examine the existing conditions and the impacts of planned developments in the Coliseum Central Business District.

BACKGROUND:

The Coliseum Central Business District is a bustling area in the City of Hampton that is home to two facilities unique to the region: the Hampton Coliseum and the Hampton Roads Convention Center. Many changes have occurred recently in the Coliseum Central Business District, and a number of mixed-use developments are planned for areas adjacent to the Coliseum and Convention Center. Some of these areas are currently used for Coliseum and Convention Center parking, which will impact traffic flow and parking for events at these facilities.

This study was done as part of the HRTPO FY 2009 Unified Planning Work Program Task 7.3 – Coliseum Central Special Events Management Plan Study and FY 2010 UPWP Task 10.1 – Transportation Technical Support. The draft report was made available for public review and comment from December 16, 2009 through December 30, 2009.

The Transportation Technical Advisory Committee has recommended approval of this report.
