Work Activity This Period:

Execute Engagement Plan

- Drafted updates to project website needed to reflect revised Phase 3 scope of work and schedule update for Independent Project Coordinator and HRTPO staff review.

Evaluating study segments on construction complexity, permitting challenges and project readiness

- Finalized assembly of environmental and construction impact data for use in task
- Applied evaluation metrics on I-664 mandated segment first to validate process and effectiveness
- Other mandated segments will be tested in the March timeframe
- This activity is a key part of segment tiering and bundling as described in the revised scope of work
