Dear Mr. Crum:

The City of Portsmouth requests a TIP Amendment from the Hampton Roads Transportation Planning Organization (HRTPO) to amend the FY 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to revise the cost estimate and allocations, and to transfer a total of \$185,649 in Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program funds from one completed Portsmouth CMAQ project to UPC 113830, another CMAQ-eligible Portsmouth project. A TIP Amendment is necessary as the transfer of funds causes the cost estimate increase to be outside of the Sliding Scale. The cost estimate increased due to the received lone bid being higher than the current estimate in VDOT's database. The fiscal constraint of the project is demonstrated.

The specifics of the request are described below:

- **UPC 113830 – Portsmouth Emergency Vehicle Preemption Software and Hardware**
 - Revise Cost Estimate as follows:
 - Preliminary Engineering (PE): \$24,049
 - Right of Way (RW): \$0
 - Construction (CN): \$699,932
 - Total Cost Estimate: \$723,981
 - Revise Allocations as follows:
 - Receive FY 2019 CMAQ allocation of \$148,519, plus \$37,130 CMAQ match, from UPC 102985
 - Revise FY Previous Local (LOC) allocation to be \$191,945

Current cost estimate, allocations, and funds available for transfer associated with the project have been confirmed with the HRTPO and Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT).

The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) requests a TIP Amendment from the Hampton Roads Transportation Planning Organization (HRTPO) to revise the cost estimate and allocations for UPC 119281, Victory Boulevard Shared Used Path in the FY 2024-27 TIP as an individual project. This project will construct a 1.2.-mile segment to complete a 2.7-mile multi-jurisdictional shared use path, improve pedestrian access to Tabb High School and the community athletic facilities, and connect to planned county developer funded ped/bicycle facilities along Yorktown Road. Fiscal constraint of the subject project is demonstrated outside the current TIP years. To that end, we request UPC 119281 be revised in the FY 2024-27 TIP including the following information:
