

SECTION 511

ALLAYING DUST

I. GENERAL

1.1 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The Contractor shall furnish all labor, supervision, material (except as herein provided), tools, equipment, supplies, and services; and, shall perform all Work necessary for providing and applying moisture on areas designated by the Owner for the purpose of allaying dust.

1.2 SUBMITTALS

Submittals shall be made by the Contractor in accordance with the procedures set forth in Section 105.

II. EXECUTION

2.1 PROCEDURES

- A. Water shall be potable unless otherwise approved by the Owner.
- B. The use of calcium chloride/lime will not be permitted.
- C. The Contractor shall furnish a truck(s) equipped with a water tank having a capacity of at least 1,000 gallons and pumps for furnishing, loading, and applying water to the roadway.
- D. Equipment and operators shall be available at all times.
- E. The Contractor shall plan and prosecute the work so as to expedite completion of the temporary or permanent surface stabilization measures as soon as is practicable.

III. MEASUREMENT FOR PAYMENT

- A. Allaying dust, complete, when identified as a separate bid item in the Bid form, will be measured on the basis of the time the truck is in service on the work.
- B. Loading time allowed for payment shall not be more than 30 minutes per thousand gallons of water.
- C. Truck hours shall be evidenced by daily time reports submitted by the Contractor and approved by the Owner.
- D. Payment will be made at the unit price bid per hour. When in-place base material is used as a riding surface to maintain traffic or as a haul route, truck hours used for allaying dust will be paid for in accordance with the provisions herein.
- E. The cost of Owner-supplied water shall be addressed as a Special Provision.
