

AGENDA ITEM #5: 2045 LONG-RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (LRTP) UPDATE

A. Project Prioritization Scores

HRTPO staff has completed the evaluation of the 2045 LRTP Candidate Projects using the Regional Scenario Planning Framework and the updated HRTPO Project Prioritization Tool, which prioritizes projects based on technical merits and regional benefits. The prioritization methodology examines transportation projects based on three components: Project Utility (project effectiveness), Economic Vitality (potential for economic gain), and Project Viability (project readiness and compatibility).

Draft Project Prioritization Scores have been distributed for review and comment to HRTPO advisory and subcommittees (TTAC, Freight Transportation Advisory Committee, Community Advisory Committee, LRTP Subcommittee, Active Transportation Subcommittee, and the Regional Transit Coordination Working Group). Feedback received has been addressed and/or incorporated. The public was also provided an opportunity to review the draft prioritization report and scores. One public comment was received from Southern Environmental Law Center, which has been forwarded to the appropriate agencies/localities and included in Appendix B of the prioritization report.

These priorities will provide a framework for the continuous pursuit of funding for the region's transportation system and will serve as a guide in the development of a fiscally-constrained 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan.
