

**ITEM #6: STATE OF TRANSPORTATION IN HAMPTON ROADS - 2020 UPDATE -
FINAL REPORT [*Action Requested*]

HRTPO staff annually produces the *State of Transportation in Hampton Roads* report. This report details the current status of all facets of the transportation system in Hampton Roads, including air, rail, water, and highways. Many aspects of the highway system are highlighted, including roadway usage, bridge conditions, costs of congestion, commuting characteristics, roadway safety, truck data, transit usage, active transportation, highway funding, tolling, and operations. Comparisons between Hampton Roads and similar metropolitan areas are also included. In addition, the 2020 State of Transportation report includes an initial analysis of the impacts of COVID-19 on many aspects of the regional transportation network.

HRTPO staff presented the draft report of the *State of Transportation in Hampton Roads Report* during the TTAC meeting on December 2, 2020 and the report underwent public review from December 2, 2020 through December 23, 2020. Comments received during the review period were incorporated into the final report. The Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) has recommended approval of the report.

Mr. Keith Nichols, HRTPO Principal Transportation Engineer, will brief the HRTPO Board on this item.
