

**AGENDA ITEM #9: THE STATE OF TRANSPORTATION IN HAMPTON ROADS 2021: FINAL**

HRTPO staff annually produces the State of Transportation in Hampton Roads report. This report details the current status of all facets of the transportation system in Hampton Roads, including air, rail, water, and highways. Many aspects of the highway system are highlighted, including roadway usage, bridge conditions, costs of congestion, commuting characteristics, roadway safety, truck data, transit usage, active transportation, highway funding, tolling, and operations. Comparisons between Hampton Roads and similar metropolitan areas are also included. In addition, the 2021 State of Transportation report includes an in-depth analysis of the impacts of Covid-19 on many aspects of the regional transportation network.

The draft State of Transportation in Hampton Roads 2021 report was made available for public review and comment from Wednesday, January 5, 2022 until Friday, January 21, 2022. No comments were received during the review period.
