

**AGENDA ITEM #10: LEVEL OF TRAFFIC STRESS ANALYSIS – HAMPTON: DRAFT**

HRTPO staff has applied a methodology to assess bicycle traffic stress on local roads to help identify low-stress bicycle-friendly roads. This methodology was recently used to analyze roadways in the City of Hampton. HRTPO staff is also currently applying this methodology to further analyze some regional trails in Hampton Roads.
