RE: FY 2021-24 HRTPO TIP Amendment UPC 119637

Dear Mr. Crum,

The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) requests a TIP Amendment from the Hampton Roads Transportation Planning Organization (HRTPO) to amend the FY 2021-24 TIP to revise the name, termini, description, cost estimate, schedule, and allocations for project UPC 119637 – Hampton Roads Express Lanes - Segment 1. This project will convert the inside shoulder along I-64 to a part-time HOT managed lane. A portion of PE is being completed under UPC 117840. The revised project termini for UPC 119637 will be referred to as Segment 1A; From 0.15 miles east of Patrol Road, To 0.661 miles east of Tidewater Drive with an approximate project length of 2 Miles. The other portion of the original termini will be a second project and added to the FY21-24 TIP as a separate UPC. To that end we request the description of UPC 119637 be amended in the FY 2021-24 TIP.

The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) requests a TIP Amendment from the Hampton Roads Transportation Planning Organization (HRTPO) to add project UPC T26347 – Hampton Roads Express Lanes - Segment 1B in the FY 2021-24 TIP. This project will convert the inside shoulder along I-64 to a part-time HOT managed lane. A portion of PE is being completed under UPC 117840. The project is the second segment of the previous project termini for UPC 119637 will be referred to as Segment 1B, From 0.661 miles east of Tidewater Drive, To 1.04 miles east of I-264 with an approximate project length of 7 Miles. To that end we request UPC T26347 be added to the FY 2021-24 TIP.
