

AGENDA ITEM #9: LEVEL OF TRAFFIC STRESS ANALYSIS – HAMPTON: FINAL

HRTPO and HRPDC staff presented the *Level of Traffic Stress Analysis: Draft* at the February 2, 2022 TTAC meeting. Staff applied a methodology to assess bicycle traffic stress on local roads to help identify low-stress bicycle-friendly roads. This methodology was recently used to analyze roadways in the City of Hampton. HRTPO staff is also currently applying this methodology to further analyze some regional trails in Hampton Roads.

The draft Level of Traffic Stress Analysis for the City of Hampton report (available at the link below) was made available for public review and comment from February 2 through February 16, 2022. There were no comments.
