

AGENDA ITEM #10: HRTPO ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION: UPDATE

Active transportation is all forms of human-powered transportation and is an important component of a complete multimodal transportation system. Numerous policies, plans, codes, and regulations support increased focus on active transportation to provide healthy, low cost, and equitable transportation choices for all users of the regional transportation network. In recent years, HRPTO staff has dedicated resources to improving the consideration and incorporation of active transportation in the MPO planning process and programs. This includes developing a regional active transportation plan (*Linking Hampton Roads*), using the HRPTO Project Prioritization Tool to evaluate candidate bicycle and pedestrian projects, engaging regional stakeholders on active transportation studies, as well as funding and implementing active transportation projects in the region.

Dr. Robert Case, HRTPO Chief Engineer, and Mr. Steve Lambert, Transportation Planner II, will brief the TTAC on current and planned active transportation efforts.
