

ITEM #14: I-64 HAMPTON ROADS BRIDGE TUNNEL EXPANSION PROJECT UPDATE

The I-64 Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel has long been one of the most congested corridors in the Hampton Roads region. The existing tunnels were opened in 1957 (current westbound lanes) and 1976 (current eastbound lanes) and are approximately 7,500 feet long. Traffic on the four-lane facility exceeds 100,000 vehicles per day during peak summer traffic.

The Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel Expansion Project will reduce congestion in the corridor with the addition of four traffic lanes in the tunnel section and capacity improvements along I-64 from Settlers Landing Road in Hampton to the I-564 interchange in Norfolk.

Mr. James Utterback, HRBT Expansion Project Director, will brief the HRTPO Board on this item.
