

## **ITEM #11: PROJECT STATUS UPDATE: VDOT**

### **A. I-64 PENINSULA WIDENING – SEGMENT 2**

The I-64 Peninsula Capacity Improvements – Segment 2 project runs from 0.54 miles east of Yorktown Road (Exit 247) to 1.05 miles west of Humelsine Parkway (Exit 242), a distance of 7.1 miles. The project involves, among other things, the addition of a 12-foot lane and 12-foot shoulder in each direction.

The updated schedule for the project is as follows:

- Public Hearing 04/30/2015
- RFP Release Date 06/10/2015
- Technical Proposals Due 09/14/2015
- Price Proposals Due 10/26/2015
- Notice of Intent to Award 11/03/2015
- CTB Approval/Award Date 12/02/2015
- Notice to Proceed 01/06/2016
- Project Completion 07/26/2019

### **B. I-64/I-264 INTERCHANGE**

The I-64/I-264 Interchange project is expected to relieve congestion and improve traffic operations from westbound I-64 to eastbound I-264. The work involves ramp widening and a new system of collector and distributor roads. The schedule for the I-64/I-264 portion of the project has been accelerated and the construction advertisements have been updated for a release date in the Spring of 2016.
