

ITEM #14: ECONOMIC IMPACT OF BICYCLE FACILITIES – PHASE ONE: FINAL REPORT

Having received a request from the City of Williamsburg to prepare a study of the economic impact of bicycle facilities, HRTPO staff has prepared Phase One of the study using existing data sources to examine a) key findings for studies of paths in other regions, and b) income, mode share, spending by visitors, bike shops, etc. in Hampton Roads, focusing on the primary tourist areas of the Historic Triangle and Virginia Beach.

The draft report was presented to the Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) on January 9, 2019 and was made available for public review and comment from January 9, 2019 through January 23, 2019. Comments received were addressed in the appendices of the final report. The TTAC has recommended approval of the report.

Dr. Robert Case, HRTPO Chief Transportation Engineer, will brief the Board on this item.
