

## **AGENDA ITEM #16: FOR YOUR INFORMATION**

### **A. OVERVIEW OF 64 EXPRESS LANES**

A public information meeting on the upcoming I-64 Express Lanes was held in the Regional Board Room on April 12, 2017. During that meeting, Virginia Secretary of Transportation, Aubrey Layne, and members of his staff and VDOT staff provided detailed information on the 64 Express Lanes project. The project will convert the existing reversible High-Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes into High-Occupancy/Toll (HOT) lanes. HOVs will continue to use the lanes for no charge, but with the conversion, single-occupant vehicles (SOVs) will be allowed to use the lanes during Express Lanes operational hours by paying a toll using E-ZPass. Outside of the Express Lanes operational hours, everyone will continue to be able to use the lanes for no charge.
