

**AGENDA ITEM #10: CONGESTION MANAGEMENT PROCESS – THE STATE OF  
TRANSPORTATION IN HAMPTON ROADS: DRAFT**

**SUBJECT:**

The draft State of Transportation in Hampton Roads 2014 Report is available for review and comment.

**BACKGROUND:**

As part of the Congestion Management Process (CMP) and our commitment to track regional performance measures, HRTPO staff annually produces the State of Transportation in Hampton Roads report. This report details the current status of all facets of the transportation system in Hampton Roads, including air, rail, water, and highways. Many aspects of the highway system are highlighted, including roadway usage, bridge conditions, costs of congestion, commuting characteristics, roadway safety, truck data, transit usage, active transportation, highway funding, and operations. Comparisons between Hampton Roads and similar metropolitan areas are also included.

The draft version of the State of Transportation 2014 report will be made available for public review and comment from May 7, 2014 through May 21, 2014. HRTPO staff intends to request approval of the final report at the June 2014 TTAC meeting.

Mr. Keith Nichols, Senior Transportation Engineer, will brief the TTAC on this item.
