

**AGENDA ITEM #7: DRIVE-THRU QUEUE STACKING REQUIREMENTS IN VIRGINIA CITIES:

Having dealt recently with queues at some fast-food restaurants spilling back into adjacent roadways and understanding that some cities vary their stacking requirements by commercial use (e.g. fast-food, drug store, bank, etc.), the City of Virginia Beach asked the HRTPO to research and document other cities' queue stacking requirements by commercial use.

Localities evaluating the appropriateness of their stacking requirements can use this research to compare their stacking requirements to those of other cities.

Dr. Rob Case, HRTPO Chief Transportation Engineer, will brief the TTAC on this item.
