

AGENDA ITEM #7: IMPACTS OF COVID-19 ON ROADWAY TRAVEL IN HAMPTON ROADS

Traffic volumes decreased significantly in Hampton Roads as COVID-19 spread across Virginia, Governor Northam enacted a stay-at-home order, and all non-essential businesses across the Commonwealth were closed. As the state has slowly reopened in recent weeks, roadway travel levels have increased, more than doubling from the lows seen in early April.

HRTPO staff has been monitoring regional travel levels during the COVID-19 pandemic using a variety of sources including Streetlight Data's VMT estimates and VDOT tunnel volume data. This analysis is included on the HRPDC's Hampton Roads COVID-19 Impact Planning Hub website (<https://hrcovid19-hrpdc-gis.hub.arcgis.com>).
