

**AGENDA ITEM #16: SOUTHEASTERN PARKWAY AND GREENBELT PROJECT UPDATE:
VIRGINIA BEACH**

SUBJECT:

A new transportation analysis is being conducted for the Southeastern Parkway and Greenbelt project.

BACKGROUND:

The concept of the Southeastern Parkway and Greenbelt (SEPG) was developed in 1983. The project progressed through the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) and Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) and then stalled in 2009 when the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) rescinded its prior concurrence on the FEIS. A project is now underway by the City of Virginia Beach and the ODU Center for Innovative Transportation Solutions (CITS) to analyze the current transportation need for the SEPG using state of the art transportation modeling.

Mr. Robert Gey, City of Virginia Beach, and Dr. Michael Robinson, CITS, will brief the TTAC on this item.
