We have reviewed the Virginia Department of Transportation’s (VDOT) submission on behalf of the Hampton Roads Transportation Planning Organization to modify the National Highway System (NHS) and Strategic Highway Network (STRAHNET) in the Norfolk area. VDOT has coordinated these proposed changes with the Surface Deployment and Distribution Command Transportation Engineering Agency (SDDCTEA) and the FHWA Division Office. The SDDCTEA concurs that the proposed changes will improve military access and mobility by providing a second STRAHNET connector to the Norfolk International Terminals north gate, and as well as expanding access to the Naval Station Norfolk main gate. The changes will provide critical defense access, continuity, and emergency capabilities for movements of personnel and equipment to and from military installations in the Norfolk area.

The requested changes are in accordance with the requirements of 23 CFR 470, and I hereby approve the modifications as follows:
