

AGENDA ITEM #6: CTAC INVOLVEMENT AND THE FY 2015 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM

SUBJECT:

A discussion of the role of CTAC members and the FY 2015 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).

BACKGROUND:

The HRTPO CTAC was formed in 2010 in order to provide the HRTPO with a citizen's viewpoint on regional transportation issues, strategies, funding, priorities, and the decision-making process of the HRTPO. Although the CTAC has contributed to the planning activities of the HRTPO, CTAC members and HRTPO staff have worked to identify ways in which the CTAC could have a more significant impact on the day-to-day functions of the HRTPO.

HRTPO staff has proposed that the CTAC utilize the HRTPO's Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) as a means to not only remain informed on all projects and programs that HRTPO staff is working on, but also as a way to provide constructive, immediate guidance, feedback, and insight from the public's perspective.
