

AGENDA ITEM #9: FY 2018-2021 TIP REVISION REQUEST: REQUEST TO TRANSFER CMAQ FUNDING: UPC 103059 – NEWPORT NEWS

Attached is a request from the City of Newport News to amend the FY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to transfer a total of \$257,015 in Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) funds from one completed project to another CMAQ eligible project in the City. The specifics of the request are described below:

- UPC 103059 – Citywide Pedestrian Improvements
 - Receive \$257,015 of FY 2010 CMAQ funds, including State match, from J. Clyde Morris Boulevard Sidewalk – Phase 5 (UPC 83435)

Should the HRTPO approve the CMAQ fund transfer described above, the FY 2018-2021 TIP will be amended as applicable. This request has been made available for public review and comment from July 3, 2018 through July 17, 2018.

Mr. Bryan Stilley, Engineer II, City of Newport News, will brief the TTAC on this item.
