

ITEM #8: STATE OF TRANSPORTATION IN HAMPTON ROADS

HRTPO staff annually produces the State of Transportation in Hampton Roads report. This report details the current status of all facets of the transportation system in Hampton Roads, including air, rail, water, and highways. Many aspects of the highway system are highlighted, including roadway usage, bridge conditions, costs of congestion, commuting characteristics, roadway safety, truck data, transit usage, active transportation, highway funding, and operations. Comparisons between Hampton Roads and similar metropolitan areas are also included.

The draft version of the State of Transportation 2015 report is available for public review and comment from July 1, 2015 through July 29, 2015.

Mr. Keith Nichols, Principal Transportation Engineer, will brief the HRTPO Board on this item.
