

**H. FY 2018-2021 TIP AMENDMENT: UPC 111926  
I-64 PENINSULA WIDENING – SEGMENT I (CHILD PROJECT OF UPC 104905)**

The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) has requested to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add a child project. The specifics of the request are described below:

- 111926 – I-64 Peninsula Widening – Segment I (Child project of UPC 104905)
  - Add project to TIP
  - Description: Funding provided by HRTAC to the HRTPO TIP under parent project UPC 104905 to repair existing lanes and add one eastbound and westbound 12 ft. lane and 12 ft. medium shoulder through projects limits; strength/widen east and westbound outside shoulders between Ft. Eustis Boulevard and Jefferson Avenue interchanges.
  - Cost Estimate as follows:

    - Total Cost Estimate: \$11,608,385
  - Schedule as follows:

This project is the child project of UPC 104905 which is considered regionally significant and was included as such in the Hampton Roads FY 2018–2021 TIP and 2040 LRTP that received a conformity finding from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) dated October 29, 2018. UPC 104905 is now complete and in financial closeout. The child project is being added to the FY 2018-2021 TIP for accounting purposes only.

This request was made available for public review and comment from July 3, 2019 through July 17, 2019. The Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) has recommended approval of the TIP amendment.
