

**H. FY 2018-2021 TIP REVISION: REQUEST TO TRANSFER CMAQ FUNDING: UPC 98815
GODWIN BOULEVARD PARK AND RIDE LOT IN SUFFOLK**

The City of Suffolk has requested to amend the FY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to transfer a total of \$54,030 in Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program (CMAQ) funds from one completed project to another CMAQ eligible project in the City to cover an increase in the cost estimate. The specifics of the request are described below:

- UPC 98815 – Godwin Boulevard Park and Ride Lot
 - Revise Cost Estimate as follows:
 - Total Cost Estimate: \$1,184,030
 - Receive \$54,030 in FY 2013 CMAQ funds, including State match, from Bridge Road and Bennett’s Pasture Road Intersection Improvements (UPC 100604)

Should the HRTPO Board approve the CMAQ fund transfer described above, the FY 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) will be amended to update the funding information associated with the affected projects. This request was made available for public review and comment from May 31, 2018 through June 14, 2018. The Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) has recommended approval of the TIP amendment.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Approve the CMAQ fund transfer and the associated TIP amendment.
