

ITEM #14: FEDERAL QUADRENNIAL CERTIFICATION REVIEW OF THE HRTPO: *Ivan Rucker, FHWA*

SUMMARY:

Federal law requires that the FHWA and the FTA certify that the metropolitan transportation planning process in MPOs is carried out in accordance with applicable provisions of federal law at least once every four years.

Mr. Ivan Rucker, Highway Safety Programs Manager/Freight and Emergency Coordinator, FHWA, will brief the HRTPO Board on this item.

BACKGROUND:

The HRTPO Quadrennial Federal Planning Certification Review of the transportation planning process for the region, commenced on March 29, 2016. The formal review process began on March 30, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. and concluded at 4:00 p.m. The discussion continued from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on March 31, 2016. There were opportunities for the public to express thoughts and comments on the transportation planning process on the evening of March 29, 2016 from 4:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.. The preliminary results of the Certification Review will be discussed.
