

AGENDA ITEM #11: REGIONAL PERFORMANCE MEASURES – FY 2014 UPDATE: FINAL

In 2009, the General Assembly passed legislation giving the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) authority to:

“require that appropriate regional organizations develop...quantifiable measures and achievable goals for the urban region relating to, but not limited to, congestion reduction and safety, transit and high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) usage, job-to-housing ratios, job and housing access to transit and pedestrian facilities, air quality, movement of freight by rail, and per capita vehicle miles traveled.”

In April 2012, the HRTPO Board approved targets for Hampton Roads’ Regional Performance Measures (RPMs) and 2012 values for these RPMs, and forwarded both to the Office of the Secretary of Transportation.

In FY 2014, HRTPO staff prepared the FY 2014 update of RPM values using the latest data available. At the July 2, 2014 TTAC meeting, Dr. Robert Case, Principal Transportation Engineer, provided the TTAC with a briefing on the FY 2014 RPM update.

This data was made available for public review and comment from July 2, 2014 through July 16, 2014. No public comments were received. The final report is enclosed.
