

AGENDA ITEM #21: GUIDE FOR ADDING HISTORICAL MARKERS FOR BIRTHPLACE OF AMERICA TRAIL: DRAFT

After an extensive planning process, a recommended route for the Birthplace of America trail was approved by the HRTPO Board on July 20, 2017. In 2017 Delegate David Yancey (94th District) informed HRTPO staff of his interest in the Birthplace of America Trail highlighting local history, particularly Revolutionary War history. The purpose of this document is to guide the developers of segments of the Birthplace Trail (VDOT, localities, etc.) in the inclusion of historical markers in segment construction.
