

**AGENDA ITEM #11: THE STATE OF TRANSPORTATION IN HAMPTON ROADS 2016:

HRTPO staff annually produces the State of Transportation in Hampton Roads report. This report details the current status of all facets of the transportation system in Hampton Roads, including air, rail, water, and highways. Many aspects of the highway system are highlighted, including roadway usage, bridge conditions, costs of congestion, commuting characteristics, roadway safety, truck data, transit usage, active transportation, highway funding, and operations. Comparisons between Hampton Roads and similar metropolitan areas are also included.

The draft State of Transportation 2016 report was presented to the TTAC on July 6, 2016 and made available for public review and comment from July 6, 2016 through August 3, 2016. Comments received have been addressed in the final report.
