Volpe, the National Transportation Systems Center, a research agency within the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT), has recently completed a draft report, *Hampton Roads Climate Impact Quantification Initiative: Scoping Paper and Preliminary Baseline Assessment of the Transportation Assets in Hampton Roads*. This report was written in support of the ODU-led Intergovernmental Pilot Project, with the intention of completing additional products in the future for the Hampton Roads region. Staff of both the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission (HRPDC) and the HRTPO have been exploring future opportunities to work with Volpe and USDOT on future phases.
