

F. HRTPO PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT PROCESS INCLUDING FY14 UPDATE OF REGIONAL PERFORMANCE MEASURES (RPMs): FINAL

Although the current federal transportation legislation—MAP-21—newly focuses on performance management, the HRTPO has been conducting transportation performance management for 20 years. This report summarizes the HRTPO’s current system of managing transportation performance. The document also presents the latest values of the HRTPO Regional Performance Measures (RPMs) originally developed in response to Virginia HB 30 (2010). HRTPO staff prepared the latest RPM values using the latest data available.

The TTAC was briefed on the draft FY 2014 RPM update report in July 2014 and the draft was made available for public review and comment from July 2, 2014 through July 16, 2014. No public comments were received. The TTAC has recommended approval of the RPM update.

Dr. Robert Case, Principal Transportation Engineer, briefed the HRTPO Board on this item under Workshop Agenda Item #10. The final report is Enclosure 10.
