

**AGENDA ITEM #13: U.S. BICYCLE ROUTE 76 SOUTHSIDE HAMPTON ROADS SPUR –
PROPOSED WORKING GROUP: VDOT**

U.S. Bike Route 76, also known as the Transamerica Route, is a designated bicycle touring route that extends from Astoria, Oregon to Yorktown, Virginia. The route traverses the Commonwealth of Virginia from the western border with Kentucky to its terminus at Yorktown. U.S. Bike Route 76 and north-south U.S. Bike Route 1 have made Virginia a destination for bicycle touring.

The VDOT Pedestrian and Bicycle Advisory Committee (PABAC) has discussed the possibility of designating a spur route of U.S. Bike Route 76 that would utilize the Jamestown-Scotland ferry to access Southside Hampton Roads, with the spur ultimately terminating at the Virginia Beach Oceanfront.

Mr. John Bolecek, VDOT Statewide Bicycle and Pedestrian Planner, will brief the TTAC on this item.
