

**AGENDA ITEM #15: STATE OF TRANSPORTATION IN HAMPTON ROADS: FINAL

HRTPO staff annually produces the State of Transportation in Hampton Roads report. This report details the current status of all facets of the transportation system in Hampton Roads, including air, rail, water, and highways. Many aspects of the highway system are highlighted, including roadway usage, bridge conditions, costs of congestion, commuting characteristics, roadway safety, truck data, transit usage, active transportation, highway funding, and operations. Comparisons between Hampton Roads and similar metropolitan areas are also included.

The draft *State of Transportation in Hampton Roads 2018* report was made available for public review and comment from September 6, 2018 through September 21, 2018. Comments received were addressed in the final report.

Mr. Keith Nichols, Principal Transportation Engineer, will brief the TTAC on this item.
