

AGENDA ITEM #10: POTENTIAL CRITERIA FOR REQUIRING TRAFFIC IMPACT ANALYSES – A REVIEW OF CURRENT PRACTICES: FINAL Rob Case, HRTPO

A Traffic Impact Analysis (TIA) estimates the impact of a proposed development on the existing roadway network and proposes any necessary related improvements.

The report provides a comprehensive review of the criteria localities use for requiring a Traffic Impact Analysis in response to rezoning or conditional use permits.

The draft *Criteria for Localities Requiring Traffic Impact Analyses Report* was made available for public review and comment from September 7, 2022 through September 21, 2022. Since that time, the report title was changed to *Potential Criteria for Requiring Traffic Impact Analyses – A Review of Current Practices*. Comments received were incorporated into the final report.
