

**AGENDA ITEM #7: 2045 LONG-RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (LRTP) UPDATE –**

**SUBJECT:**

An overview of the 2045 Long-Range Transportation Plan.

**BACKGROUND:**

As the region's Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), one of the core functions of the HRTPO is to develop, approve, and maintain a fiscally-constrained LRTP. With a planning horizon of 20 years, the LRTP serves as the blueprint for enhancing the region's multimodal transportation system. The LRTP is updated periodically to reflect changing conditions such as new planning priorities, population projections, economic change, and anticipated travel demand. The current LRTP with a horizon year of 2040 was adopted in June 2016.

HRTPO staff has initiated the process of updating the LRTP to the horizon year 2045. To date, a socioeconomic forecast has been developed and approved by the Board.
