A. STRATEGIC HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN ROAD SHOW

The Virginia Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) is a statewide, comprehensive safety plan that provides a blueprint for reducing fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads. VDOT and other key agencies (including the HRTPO) have initiated the process of updating the Virginia Strategic Highway Safety Plan. C. FINAL RELEASE OF USDOT CLIMATE IMPACT REPORT

The U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) has released the final version of the report, *Hampton Roads Climate Impact Quantification Initiative: Baseline Assessment of the Transportation Assets & Overview of Economic Analyses Useful in Quantifying Impacts*. This report was completed by Volpe, the National Transportation Systems Center, which is a research agency within USDOT. Mr. Alan Strasser, Federal Highway Administration Project Coordinator and Stakeholder Liaison with the USDOT Center for Climate Change and Environmental Forecasting, briefed TTAC on this item on September 7, 2016. Staff of both the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission (HRPDC) and the HRTPO will continue to coordinate and work with Volpe and USDOT on future phases.
