

C. FY 2021-2024 TIP Amendment: VDOT

UPC 120317 – I-64 – Transit Route 972 – Tidewater to NNSB via HRBT

Attached is a request from the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to amend the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add one project in the region. The specifics of the request are described below:

 - Description: One new MAX vehicle and service changes to the existing MAX Express Route 972 to add one AM Peak trip and one PM Peak trip
