

AGENDA ITEM #14: I-264 CORRIDOR EVALUATION STUDY UPDATE

The Virginia Department of Transportation contracted the services of AECOM to conduct a corridor evaluation study for the I-264 corridor. The purpose of this effort is to conduct a corridor evaluation study that includes existing traffic data collection, current and future operation analysis, access management analysis for compliance with current State and FHWA policy for interstates, identification of current interstate deficiencies geometrically and otherwise, with the focus on interchange and main line improvements assessed at a proposed level to maintain adequate Levels of Service (LOS) and also to evaluate the policy points listed in the VDOT/FHWA policy for an Interstate Justification Report (IJR) at the various interchanges in the study area.
