

U.S. DOT FASTLANE Program: FY 2017 Grant Opportunity

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Fostering Advancements in Shipping and Transportation for the Long-Term Achievement of National Efficiencies (FASTLANE)

- Established in the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act December 2015.
- Purpose is to fund critical freight and highway projects across the country.
- Managed by the USDOT Build America Bureau.
- Grants totaled \$800 million in 2016 - \$850 million available in FY 2017.
- Goal of the FASTLANE program is to move people and goods more efficiently.
- Deadline for FASTLANE project applications is December 15, 2016



HRTPO FY-2017 FASTLANE Grant Proposal

I-64 Southside and High-Rise Bridge – Phase I

- Phase 1 cost estimate = \$600 million
- Project is in HRTPO fiscally constrained 2040 LRTP
- Project is in FY 2016-2022 HRTAC Funding Plan – (\$600 million)
- Project submitted for SMART SCALE consideration (\$100 million)
- Project is “shovel ready”
- HRTPO staff proposes to submit project for FASTLANE grant consideration (\$100 million)



Recommended Action

- Authorize the Executive Director to submit a FASTLANE Application for the I-64 Southside and High-Rise Bridge – Phase 1 project.
- Action to be taken under Meeting Agenda Item #17-E.
