

AGENDA ITEM #6: STATE OF TRANSPORTATION IN HAMPTON ROADS: DRAFT

HRTPO staff annually produces the *State of Transportation in Hampton Roads* report. This report details the current status of all facets of the transportation system in Hampton Roads, including air, rail, water, and highways. Many aspects of the highway system are highlighted, including roadway usage, bridge conditions, costs of congestion, commuting characteristics, roadway safety, truck data, transit usage, active transportation, highway funding, tolling, and operations. Comparisons between Hampton Roads and similar metropolitan areas are also included. In addition, the 2020 State of Transportation report includes an initial analysis of the impacts of COVID-19 on many aspects of the regional transportation network.

The draft *State of Transportation in Hampton Roads 2020* report will be made available for public review and comment after the TTAC meeting.

Mr. Keith Nichols, Principal Transportation Engineer, will brief the TTAC on this item.
