SUBJECT:

Operational overview of the Williamsburg Area Transit Authority (WATA).

BACKGROUND:

Williamsburg Area Transit Authority (WATA) is the successor of James City County Transit (JCCT) and Williamsburg Area Transport (WAT). JCCT began in 1977 as a James City County and Virginia Social Services transportation system which used flexible routes to serve those most in need of transportation.

Today, the service has developed into a public transportation authority that is the only one of its kind in the State. As a distinct political subdivision, the Authority is governed jointly by James City County, York County, and the City of Williamsburg, and is also contractually tied with The Colonial Williamsburg Foundation and the College of William and Mary.

Mr. Zach Trogdon, Executive Director, WATA, will brief the Task Force on this item.
