**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITIZEN TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE HAMPTON ROADS TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION (HRTPO) REGARDING BRIEFINGS ON MILITARY TRANSPORTATION ISSUES.**

**WHEREAS**, Hampton Roads has a very large military presence, including the largest United States Naval Base in the World;

**WHEREAS**, according to the United States Navy, approximately 125,000 Navy personnel travel to area bases during a typical weekday;


**WHEREAS**, *Military Transportation Needs* is included in the Unified Planning Work Program for fiscal year 2011 as one of the four HRTPO planning priorities for the metropolitan planning area; and


**WHEREAS**, the HRTPO has stated in its FY 2011 Unified Planning Work Program that the Board believes it is important to take military transportation needs into account in the transportation planning and programming processes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the HRTPO Citizen Transportation Advisory Committee recommends that the HRTPO Board schedule an annual brief from a representative of the Navy; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the HRTPO Citizen Transportation Advisory Committee recommends that a representative of the military brief the Commonwealth Transportation Board at least once every year.
