**A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FROM THE HAMPTON ROADS TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR PROJECTS TO BE SUBMITTED FOR EVALUATION UNDER THE SMART SCALE PRIORITIZATION PROCESS.**

**WHEREAS**, the SMART SCALE prioritization process requires that all project submissions by Local Governments and Transit Agencies must be consistent with the regionally adopted fiscally-constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), or have an accompanying resolution of support from the respective MPO Policy Board;


**WHEREAS**, the County of James City has requested an HRTPO resolution of support in accordance with SMART SCALE requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the *HRTPO Guidance on SMART SCALE*, approved by the HRTPO Board on July 16, 2015 and updated on May 17, 2018, HRTPO staff has reviewed the proposed project and found it to be consistent with the current, fiscally-constrained 2040 LRTP and, if applicable, the fiscally-constrained Transportation Improvement Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the HRTPO hereby supports the following project to be submitted for evaluation under the SMART SCALE Prioritization Process:

- Pocahontas Trail (Route 60) Improvements
