

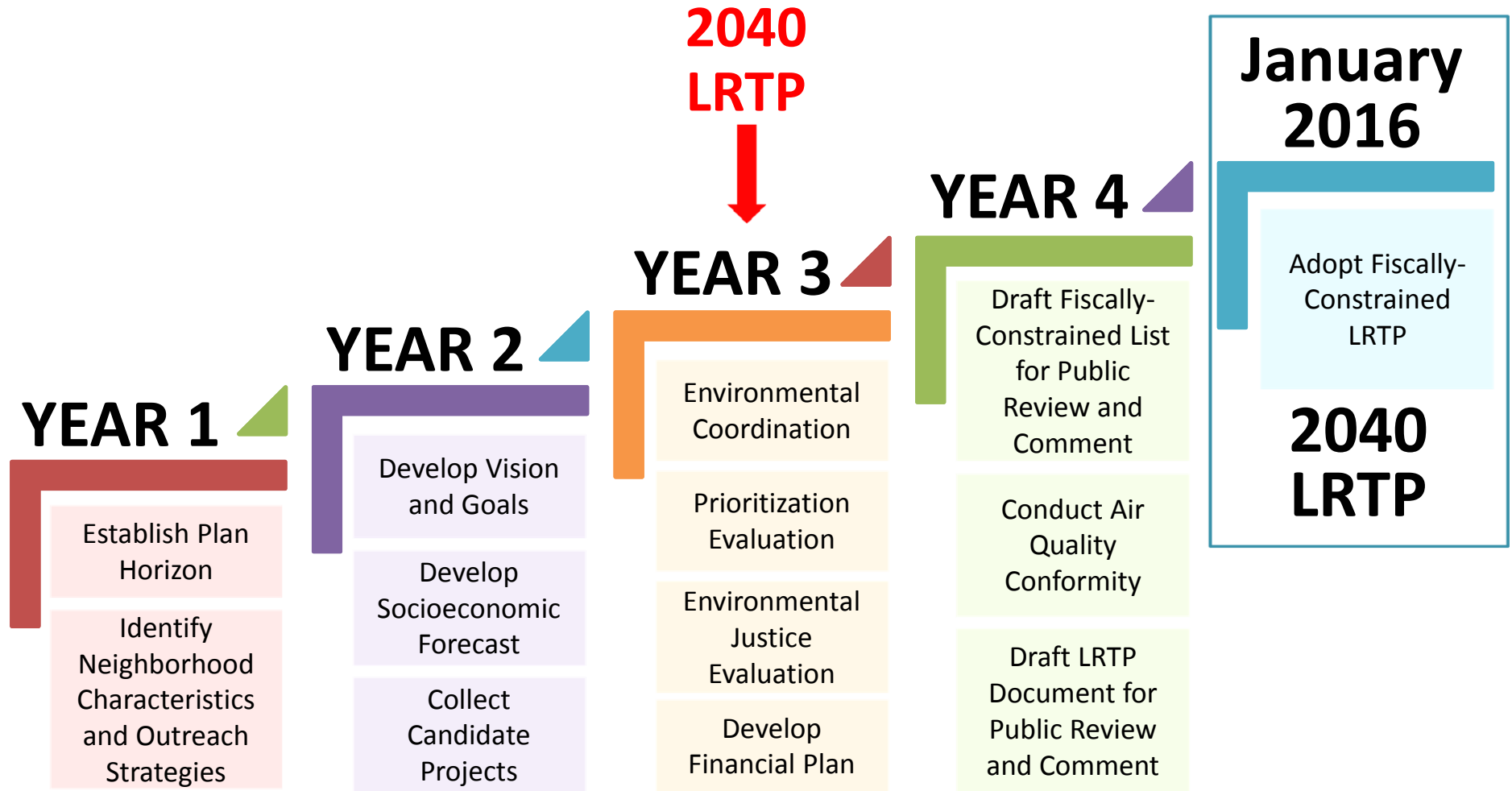

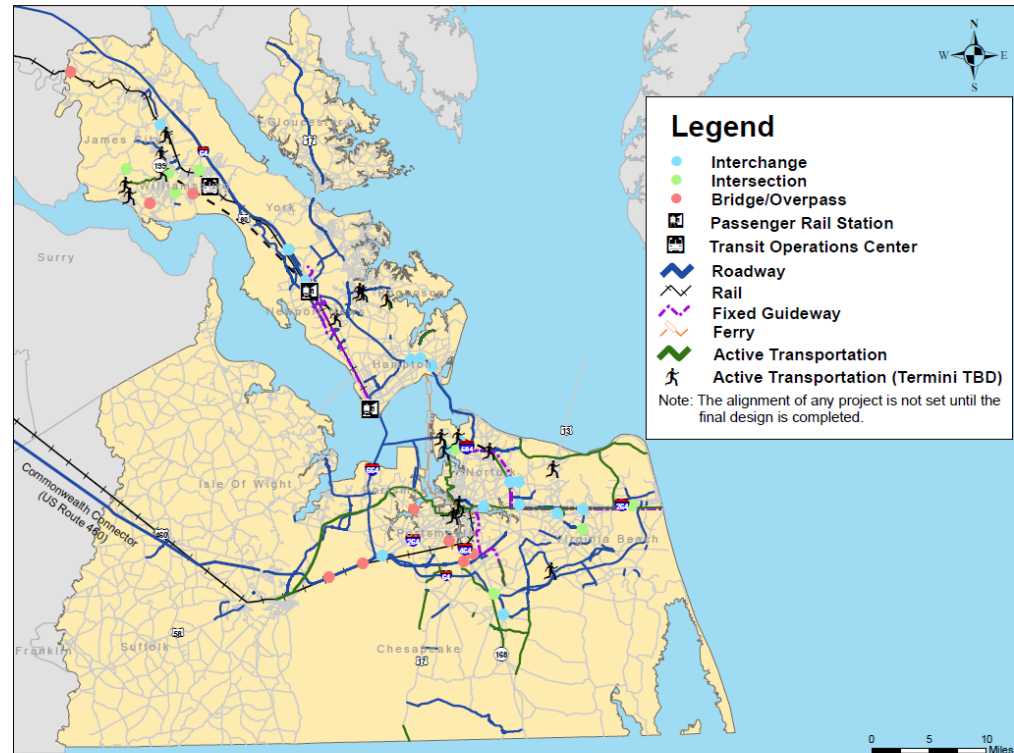

HRTPO Long-Range Transportation Plan Draft Candidate Projects (2014-2040)

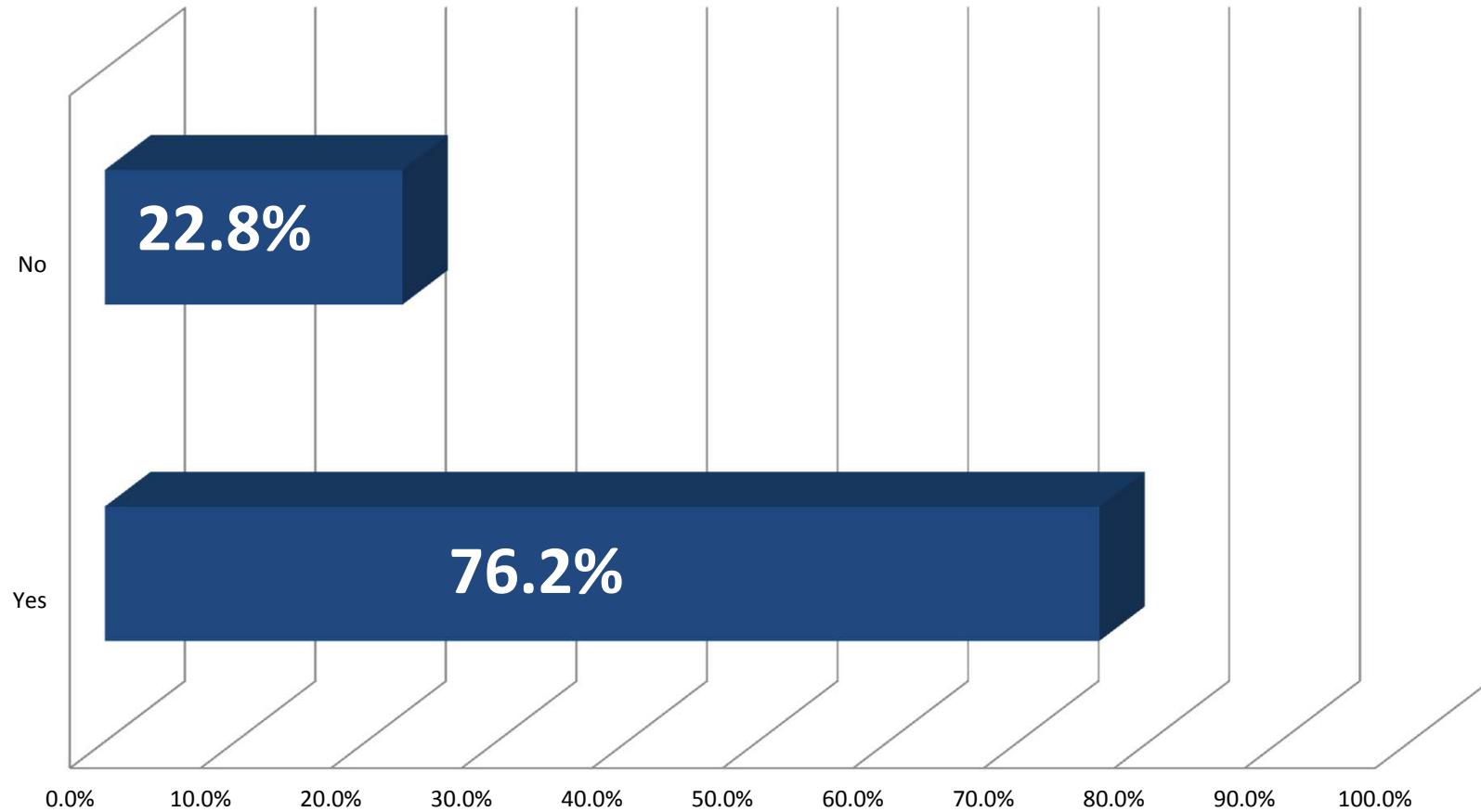

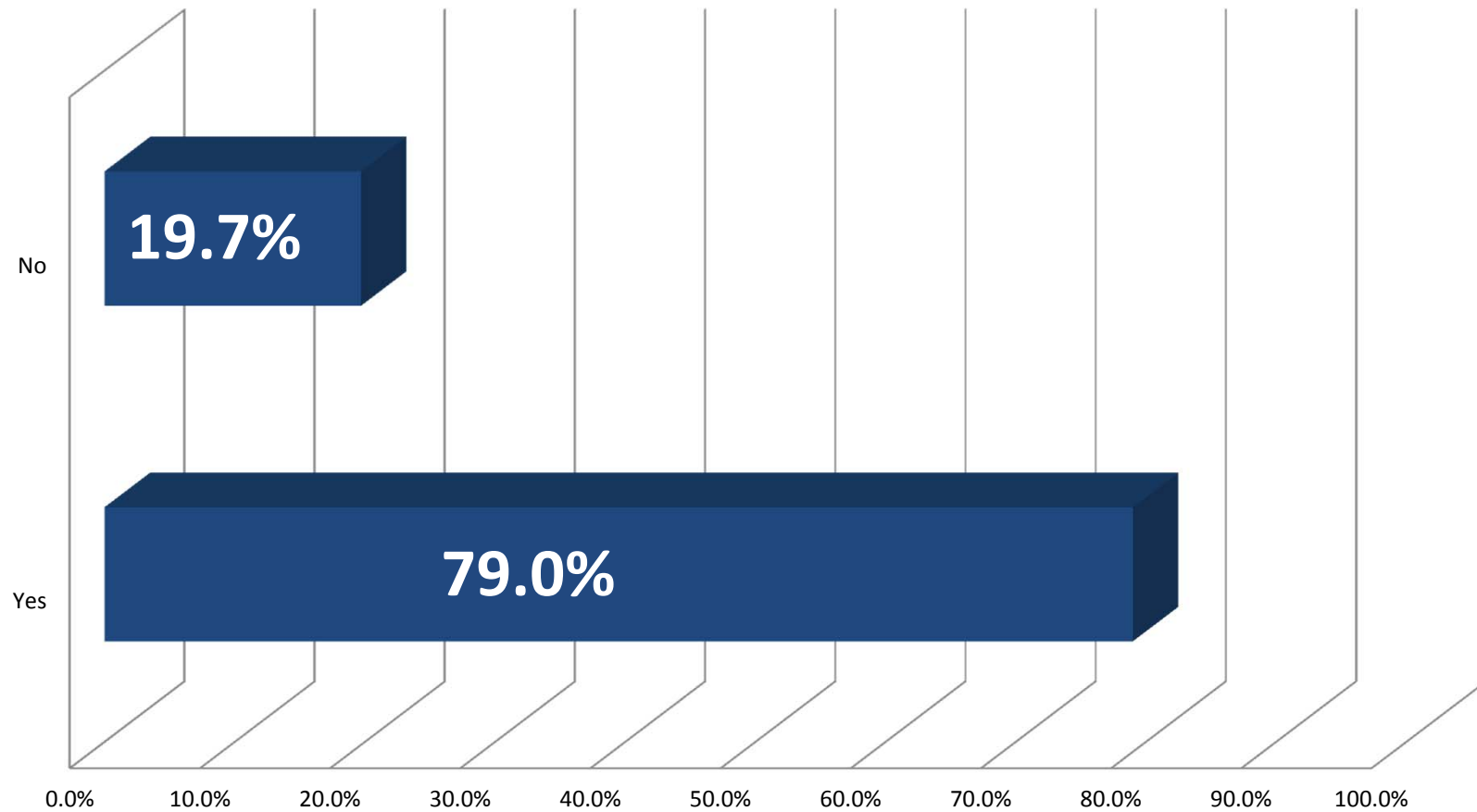
Q1: Do you think these projects will provide congestion relief?

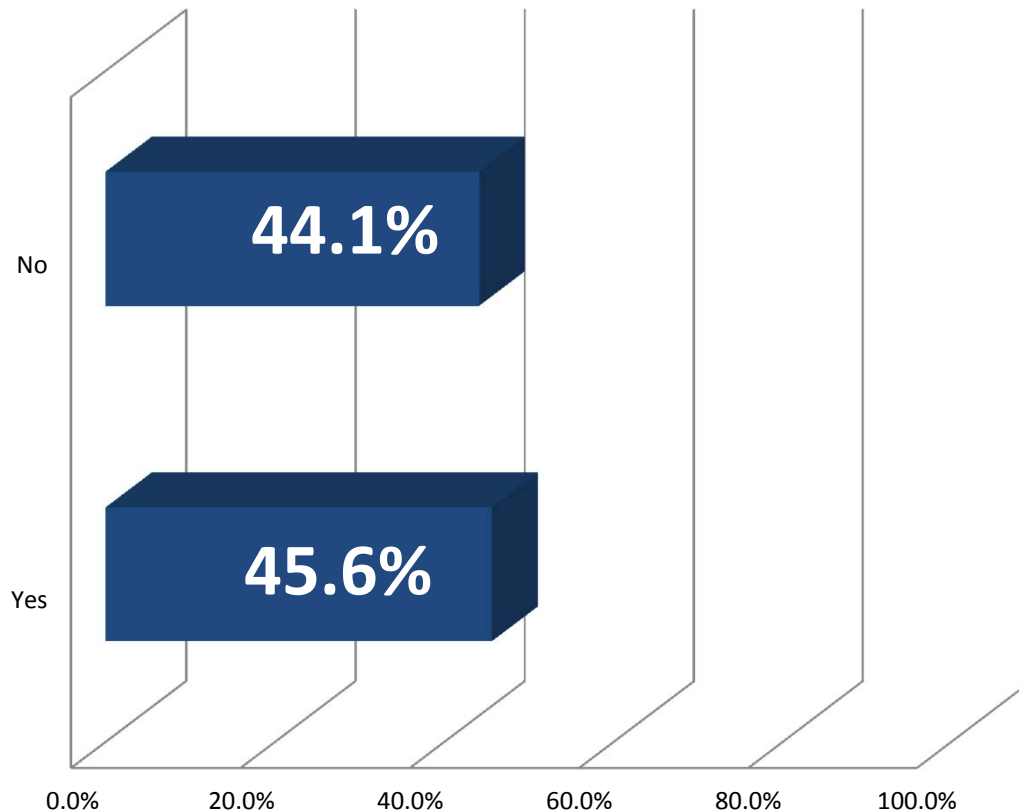
