## *FY 2017 Planning Priorities*

- ***Scenario Planning***
  - *Identify issues that affect growth in Hampton Roads*
  - *Develop alternative scenarios to meet the needs and goals of the region*
- ***Resilience of the Transportation System***
  - *Evaluate capacity of the Hampton Roads transportation system to survive, adapt, and grow in response to expected impacts such as sea-level rise, or unforeseen catastrophic events*
- ***Active Transportation***
  - *Integrate human-powered mode of transportation into the HRTPO multimodal transportation system*
- ***Connected and Autonomous Vehicles***
  - *Investigate emerging technologies associated with connected and autonomous vehicles*
  - *Evaluate the potential impact of these technologies on regional transportation planning in Hampton Roads*
